
Extensive Fire in New-Brunswick.

The hardware store of J. BUCKALEW & SON, No. 207 Burnet-street, New-Brunswick, N. J., together with two smaller buildings, Nos. 209 and 211 adjoining, were partially destroyed by fire yesterday morning. The origin of the fire is unknown. The loss is about \$15,000. The loss of BUCKALEW & SON is fully covered by insurance in the following companies: Aetna, of Hartford, \$5,000 on stock and \$2,000 on building; Jersey City, of Jersey City, \$5,000 on stock; Mutual, of New-Brunswick, \$2,000 on building; American, of Newark, and Fireman's, of Newark, \$2,000 each on stock.
