This work is a large bronze plague with a bas-relief bust in slight profile of the smiling Mason Welch Gross. Commemorating Rutgers' 16th President, it shows Gross wearing a suit jacket, shirt and tie. The plague is placed in a shallow recess of a large granite wall. A curved bench of polished granite helps form a small plaza in front of this memorial
